Requirements

- Experience in teaching History up to university entrance level
- English at a C2 fluency level (for non-native applicants)
- Good ICT skills and an understanding of ICT use in an educational context

- Experience in working with pupils whose first or second language may not be English
- Knowledge of other EU languages is an advantage
- Experience teaching History or the equivalent to EB, IB or GCE A level
